 Council has been called for March 18 for the purpose of meeting with parking meter firm representatives. Council has approved installation of the meters but has not acted to acquire them.
 Council also adopted its budget which calls for \$55,428.25 expenditures in the coming fiscal year. The ten mill tax rate will remain the same.
 An ordinance distributing the \$6.50 personal tax \$5 for general expenses and \$1.50 to pay for the alterations to the borough building was approved and will be advertised. The \$1.50 last year was allocated for the payment of fire fighting equipment.
 Council authorized the Borough Solicitor to prepare an advertisement calling for present fire house bonds to be paid. He suggested they be called in reverse order, Nos. 20, 19, 18, 17, 16, and 15. They can be paid off May 1st but will be paid earlier since the money is available from the Sinking Fund.
 Council also authorized treasurer Carl Krall to sell a U. S. treasury note of \$5,000 to help pay for the new annex. Mr. Krall reported \$67.81 interest collected on the note.
 Burgess Fish, the Ordinance committee and the secretary of the Board of Health met to draw up a revised ordinance. Said ordinance was turned over to the Borough Solicitor before it will be presented to Council.
 Fire Chief Ray Myers, reported that the debris at the Mitchell fire on Fairview street, must be cleaned up and according to the fire marshal at Harrisburg, Council is responsible. Therefore notice will be served on Goldie Sheaffer, the owner, and Mitchell, tenant, by Officer Neiss, to clean up said debris by April 1st, or the borough will have it done and bill the above mentioned parties.
 Titus Rutt presented the charter for the articles of incorporation by the Centennial Committee to Borough Council for permanent record.
 \$300 was appropriated to the Fire Company.
 Burgess Fish reported \$60 collected for peddlers license fees and \$1 for a shooting permit.
 Chief of Police Park Neiss reported these violations: 2 ignoring red light, 1 improper pass, 2 reckless driving, 1 operating with one headlight, 1 ignoring red tag, 1 drunk and disorderly conduct, 1 disorderly conduct, and 1 accident investigated, with 1,426 miles travelled by auto.
 Treasurer Krall reported a balance in the boro treasury of \$9,271.38.
 Boro bills paid amounted to \$1,678.42. Patterson coal fund \$11.50.
 Justices of the Peace James Hockenberry turned over \$77 for February fines and Robert Brown \$50 for January violations.
 Secretary of the Board of Health reported 2 whooping cough, 5 chicken-pox, 1 scarlet fever, 1 German measles and 2 nuisances.
