### EAST HEMPFIELD LOST THE CHAMPIONSHIP PLAYOFF

You only have to look at the remarkable accuracy of the East Berlin cagers from the foul line to understand how they defeated East Hempfield 56-49, to capture the PIAA Class C District Three championship at Red Lion.

The victors connected on 16 of 19 foul attempts for an 84.2 average, which is better than most marks made by the collegiate and pro teams.

Compare East Berlin's 16 pts. from the charity line to East Hempfield's seven of 21 attempts and you have the story why the title went out of Lancaster County for the first time since the 1949-50 season.

Coach Johnny Berger's proteges fought gallantly to retain the crown and even outscored the winners in the field goal department, 21 to 20.

Thus the title, which New Holland brought to Lancaster County and Mount Joy retained last year, is now resting in Adams County.

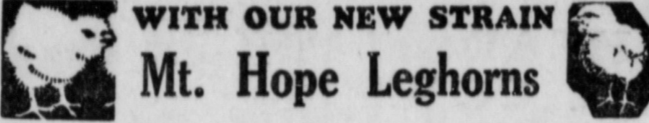
