After the vote was taken it was decided that each individual board will vote on the resolution at its next session and if any board votes against the resolution it can be el-

minated from the proposed merger. If all the boards approve the individual solicitors should meet with the joint board's solicitor and begin plans for placing it on the ballot. G. Reed Alexander, acting chairman for the session, also reported on a recent meeting with school directors from Mount Joy and Marietta boroughs, and East Donegal Twp., during which they were invited to join in a seven district merger. Alexander said the school officials of the three districts indicated they would notify the local group on their decision but no official notification has been received.
