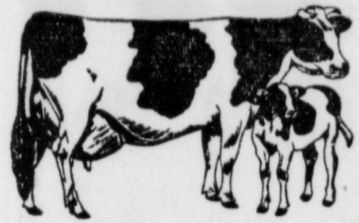

22-COW HOOD-GINDER HERD MADE QUITE A RECORD

With an average of 385 pounds of butterfat and 10,774 pounds of milk the 22-cow herd of registered Holstein-Friesians owned by Joseph A. Hook and Herman Ginder, Jr., Mt. Joy RD, completed their test year recently. The testing was carried on under the official Herd Improvement Registry program of the Holstein-Friesians Association of America.

Milking was done two times daily and testing was supervised by Pennsylvania State College in cooperation with the national Holstein headquarters.

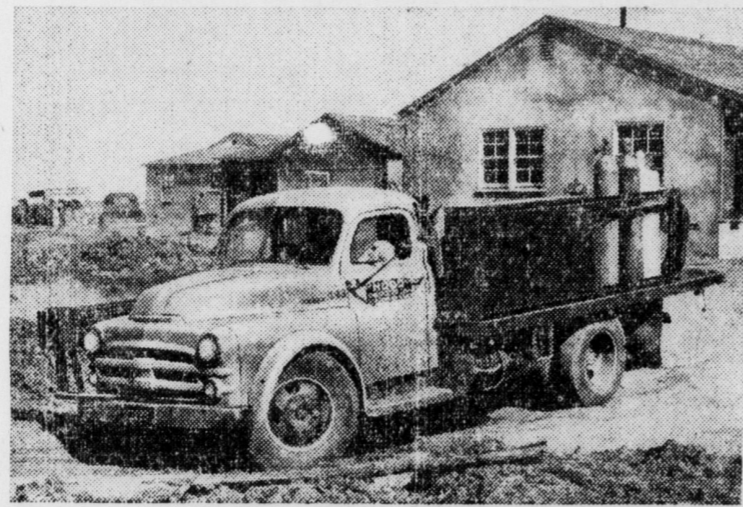

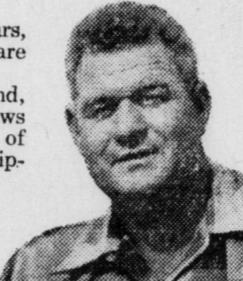
