

Conversion to Gas

The ashes of wood and coal can be converted into gas. Anything may be converted into gas or vapor if it is heated to a sufficiently high temperature. Since ashes consist of a mixture of many compounds, such as the carbonates of sodium and potassium, silica, etc., all with different boiling points, no particular temperature can be given as that which would have to be reached, though it would probably be in the neighborhood of 3000 degrees Fahrenheit.
