Landisville Farmers Herd Completes Test

Brattleboro, Vt., August 15—With an average of 393 pounds of butterfat and 10,829 pounds of milk, the 7-cow herd of registered Holstein-Friesians owned by J. Lester Charles, Landis-

ville, Pa. completed their test year recently. Their production average approximately 16 quart daily for each cow in the herd for the year. Testing was carried on under the official Herd Improvement Registry program of the Holstein-Friesian Association of America.
Milking was done two times daily and testing was supervised by Pennsylvania State College, in cooperation with the national Holstein headquarters.

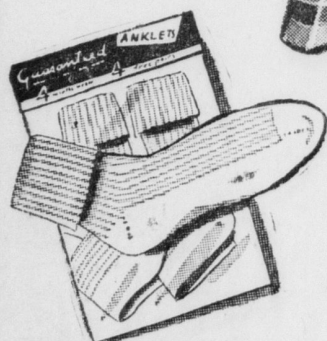

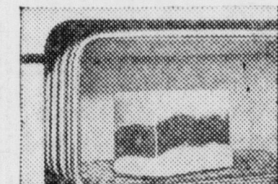
