Joint Board Awards Contracts

The Donegal Joint School Board held a meeting last Thursday night in the Marietta high school building when the Donegal School Authority, on the recommendation of the board, awarded contracts for the new joint school building.

The contract for the \$1,575,000 bond issue was awarded to Butcher and Sherrard and Dolphin and Company, both of Philadelphia, at an interest rate of 3.34 percent.

Herman Wohlsein, Lancaster, was awarded the general contract. There bid was \$799,600; Heating and ventilating, S. H. Corp., Harrisburg, for \$146,692. The S. H. S. Corp. also received the contract for plumbing, the bid being \$87,935. Roy Reidenbach, Litzitz received the electrical contract, his bid was \$114,985.

The final articles of agreement were adopted providing for the three districts to function as a joint board immediately on the awarding of the contracts.

The next meeting of the joint will be held at Mount Joy October 16.

York County Man Wins 1952 Pasture Contest

I. training class in Lancaster County and finds time to serve on the Farmers Home Administration committee for his home county.

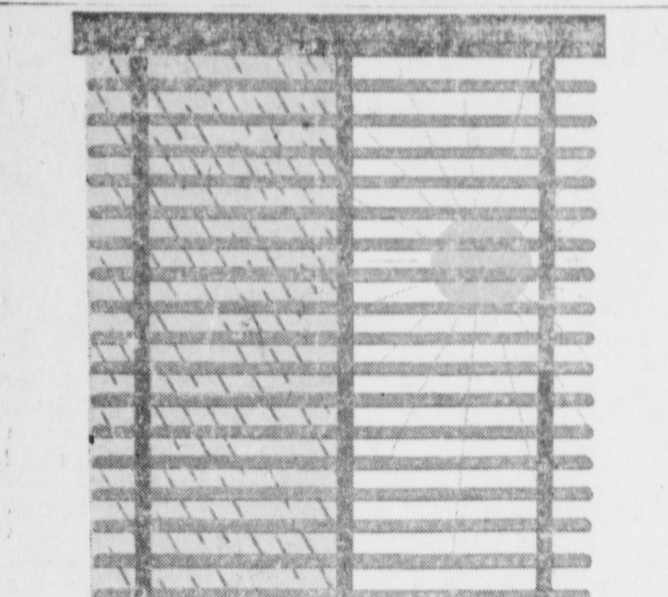
