Leroy G. Mutzer, thirty-eight, of Manheim R1, died unexpectedly Sunday morning in a Philadelphia hospital shortly after being stricken in a hotel room.

Members of his family said he had not been feeling well for about a week and had been under the care of Dr. E. Stanley Booth, Florin. They said he and his wife went to Philadelphia on Saturday for a weekend trip.

An autopsy will be performed today to determine cause of his death, according to the Philadelphia coroner's office. Dr. Booth said he had been treating Mutzer for an apparent coronary condition.

Mutzer, who operated his own trucking business, was a son of Edward M. and Victoria Gantz Mutzer, Manheim R1, and was a member of the Loyal Order of Moose 596, Elizabethtown.

Besides his parents, he is survived by his wife, the former Elizabeth Sigler, and a brother, Wilbur M. Mutzer, Manheim R1.
