Thursday night the services will be held in the Zion Lutheran Church of Landisville with the Rev. Thomas Tillett, pastor of the Landisville Church of God, delivering the evening message. On Friday night Rev. Bowers of the Salunga Brethren Church will preach the sermon in the Methodist Church of Salunga.

The closing service for this Universal Week of Prayer will be held in the Landisville Church of God on Sunday, January 11, at 7:30 p. m. The guest speaker at this community service will be the Rev. Bela Vassady of Lancaster.

Dr. Vassady lived and received his early education in his native Hungary. Since 1925 he has been a Professor of Theology in various Seminaries in Hungary. In 1946 he was guest lecturer at Princeton, McCormick, Bangor, and Union of Richmond, and more recently Professor of Biblical Theology and Ecumenics at Fuller Theological Seminary in Pasadena, and Visiting Professor of Theology at the University of Dubuque. Since September of last year, Dr. Vassady has been Professor of Systematic Theology at the Evangelical and Reformed Seminary of Lancaster, Pa.

Before Dr. Vassady moved to this country in 1948, he was the President of a Reformed Seminary in Hungary. He served for a number of years in the World Council of Churches, representing the Reformed Church of his country and serving as a member of the Central Committee of the World Council.

At this service, Dr. Vassady will speak to the combined churches of Landisville and Salunga. The public is cordially invited to attend all these services.

Junior Play
The junior class of E.D.H.S. has chosen its first play production which will be "Whoo! Auntie", a three-act comedy by Karen Asbrand. The play will be given March 14 and 15.

Practical Math Class
In East Donegal High, mathematics tends to take on renewed interest when its materials are applicable to life situations. Problems involving such applications are made more interesting and meaningful if data for them is obtained from field work using instruments constructed by the individual students. To achieve this value, the Senior Practical Mathematics Class taught by Stanley Dotterer, includes in its course this year the construction of the following simple, yet practical instruments of mathematics:

1. An enlarged slide rule to perform quickly the operation of multiplication and division.
2. An enlarged protractor for use in field work measurement

of angles.
3. A Hypometer - Clinometer for use in field work measurement of angles of elevation and depression of distances and of trigonometric values of angles.

4. An alidade and plane table for field work in locating detail in plotting maps of areas of land.

5. A quadrant and sextant for field measurement of horizontal vertical, or inclined angles with a reasonable degree of accuracy.

6. An enlarged vernier as an illustration of possible refinements for increasing accuracy of measurement.

7. A sundial for measuring time by line shadows drawn by the rays of the sun.

8. A heliotope with which signals can be flashed and messages conveyed over relatively large distances.

Next spring, surveying will also be made part of the instruction and students expect to do some outdoor work using actual surveying instruments.

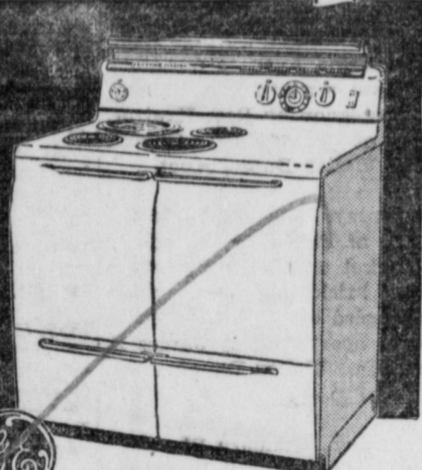

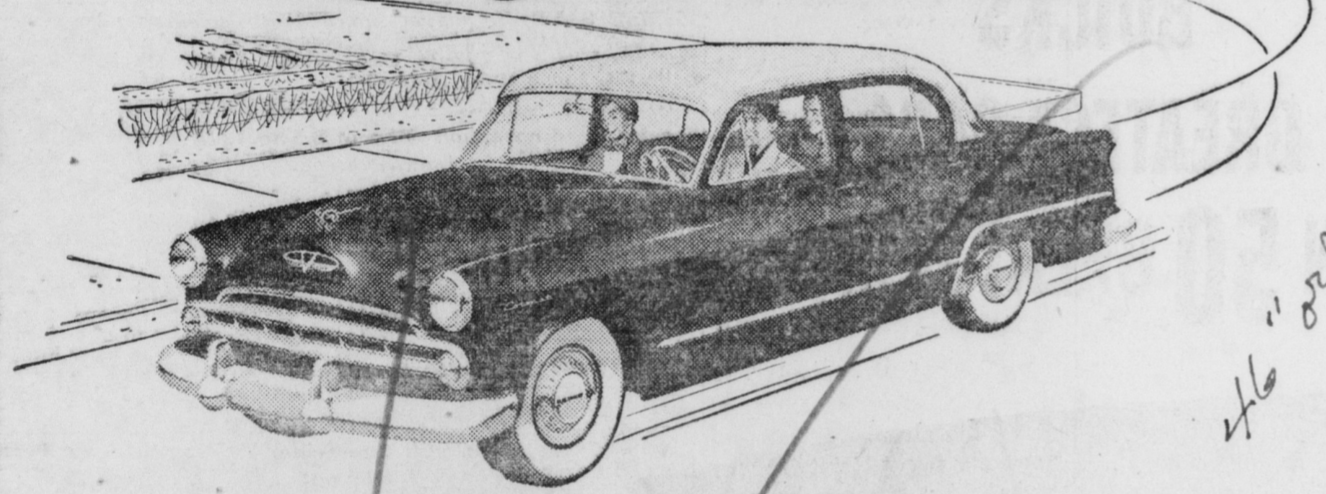
