Kraybill, was scheduled to start school in the first grade, but polio had struck the young boy before he could start school and he was confined to the Lancaster General Hospital, in the polio unit, from September 5th until Oct. 4th and then at home for a while where he received follow up treatments. Johnnie and his two sisters are very high in their praise of the Lancaster Chapter For Infantile Paralysis for what was done, not only for Johnnie but for other children and this little polio victims schoolmates collected and contributed a total of \$91.15 a very high percentage per pupil, according to polio headquarters, and it could be No. 1 for 1953, with all returns in later.

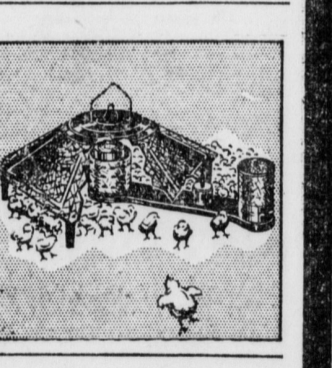
