or get into some other kind of
farming. Dr. Barr warned, how-
ever, "If you increase the num-
ber of animals, you must man-
age the herd properly? This
means using labor more effi-
ciently, possibly by changing
the arrangement of the barn or
the chore routine."**

A Public Relations Job
Simeon A. Horton, manager
of the Mount Joy Farmer's Co-
operation Assoc., suggested that
farmers do a better public rela-
tions job in explaining their
problems.

"Consumers complain about
milk prices because they do not
know how much it costs to pro-
duce milk," Horton said.

The nutritive value of milk
should be advertised," Horton
also suggested. Too often peo-
ple in the later years of life do
not drink enough milk for their
health, he said.

Ivan E. Perkins, dairy exten-
sion specialist from Penn State,
closed the meeting with discus-
sion of cold-wall tanks, pen-
stabling, and the care of milk-
ing machine and dairy utensils.
