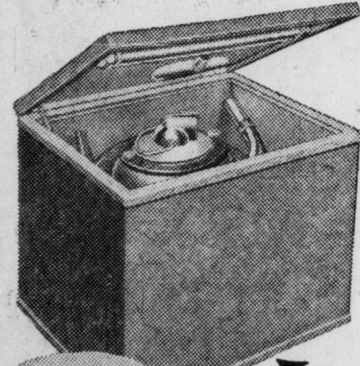

Union National Lists Additional Services

In addition to furnishing the usual commercial bank services, the Union National has added additional ones at various times.

In 1919 the Congress of the United States passed an Act allowing national banks to operate Trust Departments. Several months after meeting the requirements of this Act, the Union National was appointed guardian of four children. Since that time, it has served in two hundred or more fiduciary capacities.

Growth in assets has followed the increasing number of individuals and corporations served. Accordingly in 1919 assets totalled \$15,000.00 while they now total approximately \$1,450,000.00. The most rapid growth has occurred since 1945 at which time assets totalled \$232,000.00. Operations were completely mechanized during 1953.

The entire Board of Directors serve as a Trust Committee in stead of the usual small committee as provided by the Act. At the present time the Trust Department is serving as administrator and executor of estates, guardian of minors and incompetents, trustee under wills, and trustee of corporate pension funds and corporate bonds issues.

In 1946 a Consumer Loan Department was opened providing for the financing of automobiles, electrical appliances and home improvements. This department has maintained a steady growth and has provided thousands of its customers with prompt service at low rates.

During 1951 a Vacation Club was opened which provides for the depositing weekly of a specified sum which is repaid to the customer at the beginning of the vacation season. This recent addition to the bank's service, now in its third year, has shown a consistent growth.
