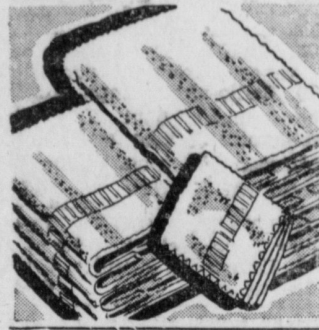

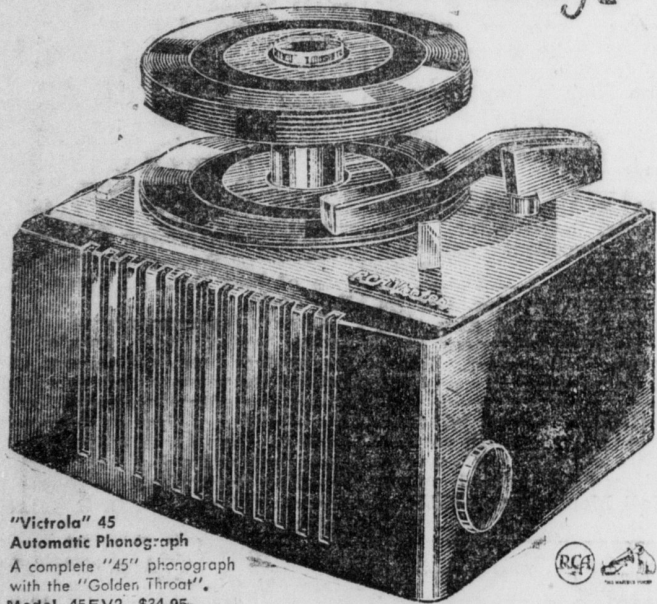

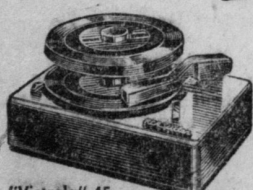

FIRE RELAY HELD AT MASTERTONVILLE BY FIREMEN OF ZONE 7

Four Zone 7 fire companies from Mastertonville, Landisville, Mount Joy and Manheim participated in a relay Sunday afternoon at Mastertonville. The firemen laid out 2,750 ft. of hose to pump water from the Little Chickies Creek to Mastertonville. Used in the relay were the new two-way radios in the Mount Joy and Mastertonville pumers which were used to relay instructions from one end of the relay to the other.

The project was arranged by the relay committee of Zone 7, Albert Zeager, of the Rheems Fire Co., chairman.
