Weak Axe Handles Are Dangerous

There is a sweet contentment and a cozy feeling, when one sits by a wood fire; that is unmatched by our modern furnaces. Cracking, pungent wood fires still heat many Pennsylvania farm homes, as wood can be had for the labor during the off season in handy woodlots. However, men who work in the woods are in continuous danger and need to practice safety so they can enjoy themselves unharmed by the fire, reminds the Division of Farm and Home Safety Education, State Department of Public Instruction.

"Weak axe handles are a menace," declares Clarence W. Funk, Pennsylvania Farm Bureau Cooperative Association. Funk and his organization are cooperating with the Division and the Safety Rural Safety Council in a state-wide effort to reduce rural accidents.

"Replace those weak handles," advises Clarence W. Funk, "and check the bit frequently for tightness on handle."

"Chop so that the handle is as nearly horizontal as possible when the axe strikes. Champion wood cutters keep their axes sharp—it makes chopping safer and easier."

"Keep area of swing clear of children or obstructions."

"Use a chopping block."

"Don't use axe as a maul."

"Store the axe properly when not in use. Place it where it cannot be stepped on or bumped and where it won't fall."

"Keep your eye on the point where you want the axe to strike."
