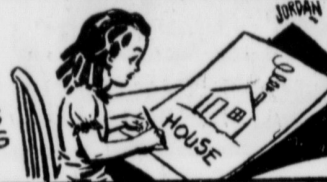

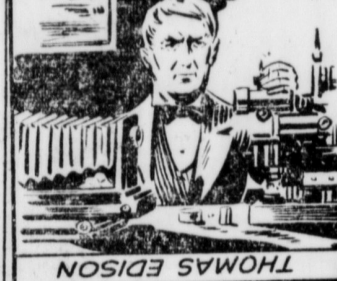

The oldest guest at the home is 100 years and 7 months.

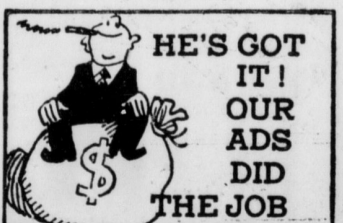
Philadelphian To Speak At Florin Church

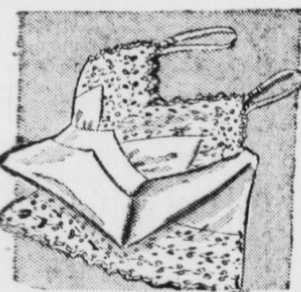

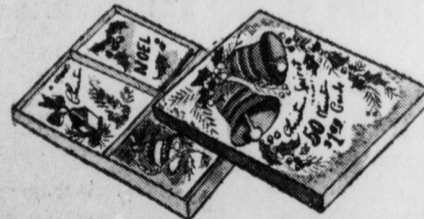
