

One indication of how successful such efforts have been was shown in a recent report by two Army physicians who treated 70 tuberof terramycin for four months.

The patients were given five grams of the antibiotic daily, instead of

the usual one gram dose.

Reporting on the patients' response to the treatment, the physicians said that none of the patients had to have the drug discontinued during the four months—and noted that such heavy doses of terramycin had scarcely ever before been given for so long a period.


