A bulletin recently released by the Council of State Govern ments and based on reports of the United States Bureau of the Census shows in proportion to the total population Pennsylvania, with an average of 22.5 state and local government employes for each thousand of our population, is next to the lowest state in the Union in the number of persons required to conduct all its state and local government affairs.

Only one other state (Kentucky), the State Planning Board of the Pennsylvania Department of Commerce points out, has a lower record of state and local government employes per thousand population.
