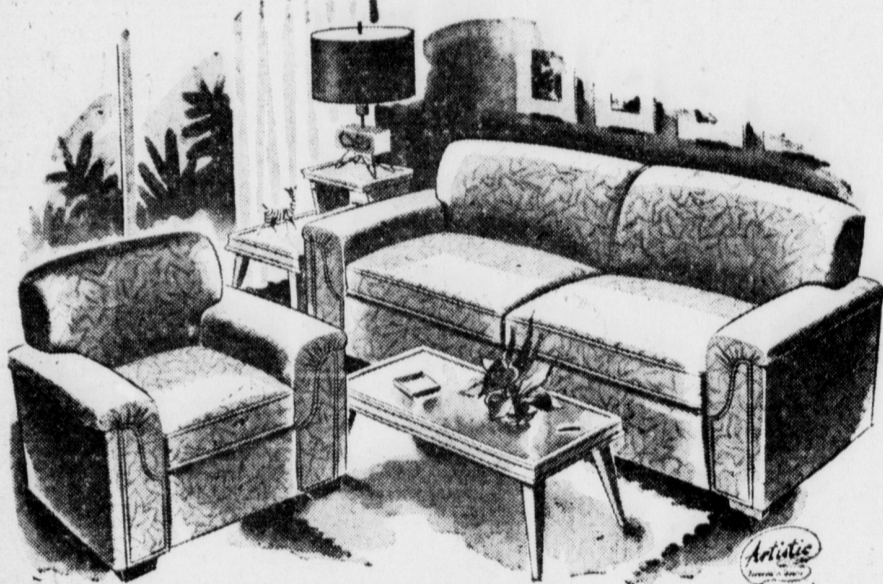

Days Of Decision Planned By Church

Plans are now completed for the Lenten series of services called Days of Decision at the Glessbrenner Evangelical United Brethren Church, Florin, Pa. The services will be an Evangelistic nature and will be held each night March 7-14.

Present plans call for a Community-wide religious emphasis by means of a window sticker campaign. The sticker suggests, "Light their life through Faith, bring them to worship this week". Every home in the community will have the opportunity to thus demonstrate their faith in God, by putting the sticker in the window. This phase of the campaign is headed by Ira Wenger, and will begin February 28.

Present plans also call for 15 teams of two each for the purpose of specialized visitation. The teams are in the process of being trained by the pastor, the Rev. John H. Gable.

Public services are planned to begin Sunday, March 7 at 7:15 P. M. and continue nightly every night of the week at 7:30 P. M. Speakers for the services are Dr. Allan S. Mevk, president of the Theological Seminary for the Evangelical and Reformed Church, Lancaster, who will speak Sunday and Monday the 7th and 8th. Dr. Clyde Meadows, pastor of King Street United Brethren Church of Chambersburg, Pa. will be the guest minister on Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday, 9-12 of March. Dr. Maynard Sparks, Chaplain of Lebanon Valley College at Annville, will be the guest minister Saturday and Sunday, March 13 and 14. Music will be provided by local talent.

A special part of each service will be the presentation of the theme "What Christ and the Church Means to Me" by folks in the local area. Some who will be taking part are Wilbur I. Beahm, Donald Wolgemuth, Miss Karleen Raffensperger, Ira Wenger, Dr. T. M. Thompson and Mrs. John K. Wittie.

Holy Communion Services of consecration will precede the beginning of this evangelistic effort.

Temperance Speaker To Be In E-Town

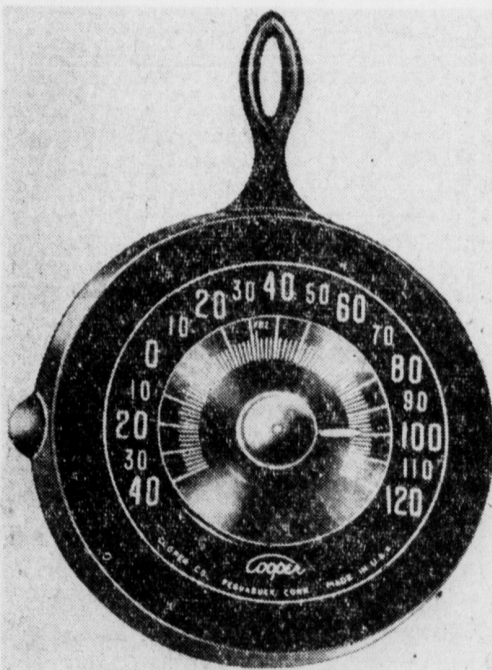

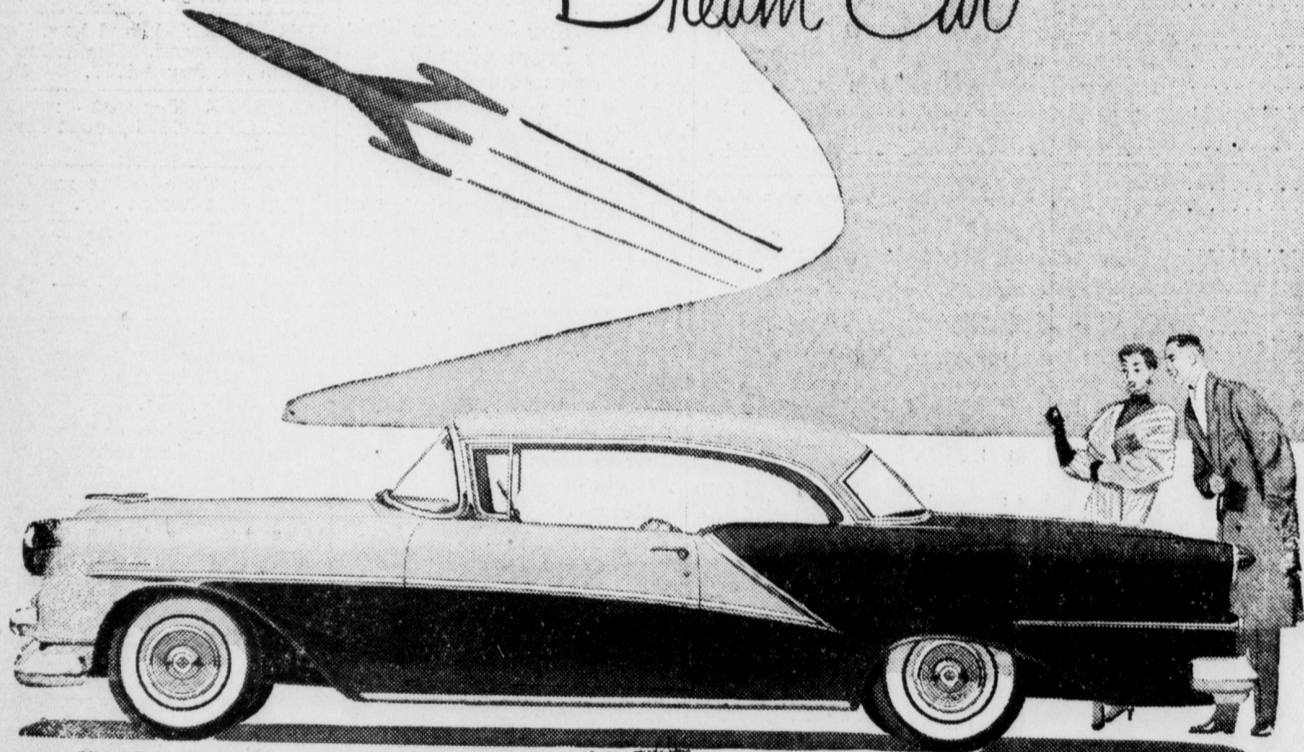
