Sticker Campaign Slated For Florin

Dr. Allen Meck To Be First Guest Speaker

The community-wide sticker campaign sponsored by the Glossbrenner Evangelical United Brethren Church, Florin, will begin Sunday, February 28 and will be completed March 7. Ira Wenger is in charge of the community wide religious emphasis and is assisted by fifty volunteer workers. This is not a denominational effort for the sticker suggests "Light Their Life With Faith; Bring Them to Worship This Week."

Along with the campaign will be given a tract entitled "Ten Reasons 'Why'". Internationally known famous persons such as General Omar Bradley, President Eisenhower, J. Edgar Hoover, Charles E. Wilson give their personal testimony concerning the value of Christ and His Church.

This campaign is a prelude to the Days of Decision, the evangelistic efforts in the Glossbrenner church which will begin March 7-14. Dr. Allen S. Meck will be the first guest minister to appear in this series of services. He will speak Sunday evening, March 7, 7:15 p. m. and March 8, 7:30 p. m. Sunday evening's theme will be "Cleric and Lay Witnesses"; Monday's will be "Open Doors into the Fold of Christ".

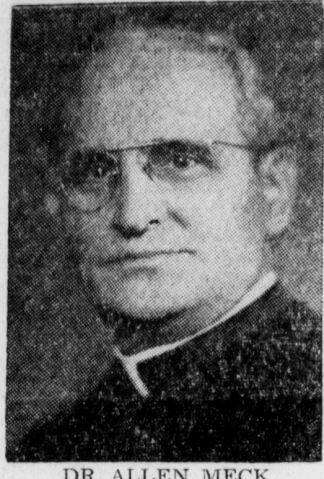
Dr. Meck is the president of the Theological Seminary of the Evangelical and Reformed Church, Lancaster. After thirty six years of active pastoral work in his church, Dr. Meck was selected to his present position. He is a graduate of Franklin and Marshall College and of the Seminary that he now serves. Ursinus College conferred the honorary degree of Doctor of Divinity upon him in 1929. In 1951 Franklin and Marshall College honored him with its L.L.D. degree. He is a member of Phi Beta Kappa.

In 1947, Dr. Meck was elected Moderator of the General Synod of the Evangelical and Reformed Church and in 1951 he was elected moderator of the Alliance of the Reformed and Presbyterian churches of North America. He has appeared in 1,070 different churches during his career as a churchman.

Succeeding evenings of Mar. 9-14, the guest ministers will be Dr. Clyde Meadows of Chambersburg and Dr. Sparks, Chaplain on the campus of Lebanon Valley College.
