## Farm Calendar

APPLY NITROGEN—An application of nitrogen on bluegrass pasture during March will provide earlier pasture, says Albert Cooper, Penn State extension agronomist. He recommends 400 to 600 pounds per acre of a 10-10-10 fertilizer which provides phosphorus and potash, too. For efficient use, limit the pasture fertilizer to one-quarter acre per cow.

ORCHARD CAUTION—You should think twice before you plant a home orchard, cautions

Carl Bittner, Penn State extension fruit specialist. Do not plant tree fruits unless you intend to take good care of them—including pruning, spraying, cultivation, and fertilization. Where space is limited, dwarf apple trees may be planted.

PROVIDE SPACE—Poultrymen who start chicks early and do not put them on range later will need larger brooding quarters so enough floor space is provided as the pullets become larger, says F. H. Leuschner, a Penn State extension poultry specialist.

CLEAN TRACTOR RADIATOR—A good spring housecleaning of the tractor radiator will insure longer radiator life by removing rust, scale, and grease and will increase the cooling efficiency, reminds Burton Horne, Penn State extension agricultural engineer.

PASTURE POULTRY—Poultry raisers who use a good legume-grass range will reduce feed costs. As Robert Lauffer, Penn State extension poultry specialist, explains it, a good range will supply green, tender, succulent, palatable, and nutritious forage all season.

CREEP-FEED PIGS—A complete balanced ration can be made available in a creep-feeder for suckling pigs, say Penn State extension livestock specialists. The creep-feeder should be located in a well-lighted area handily accessible to the pigs.

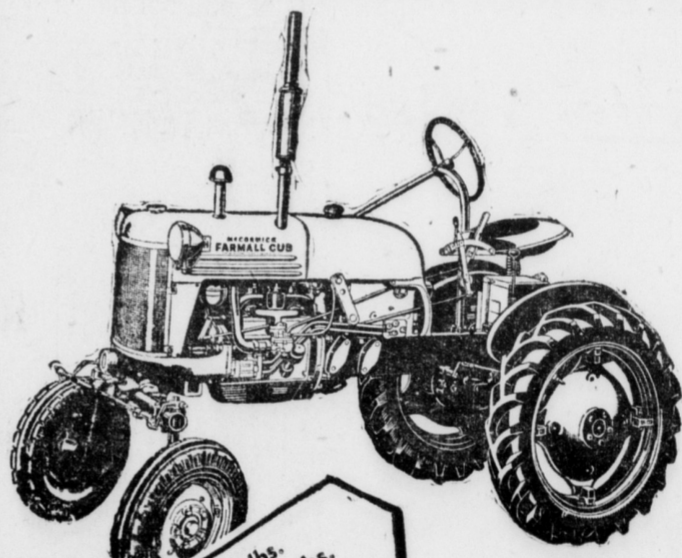
