ENGINEERS TO INSPECT NEW PENN STATE BARN

Penn State's new dairy barns have attracted hundreds of visitors since they were put into use. But they will get a new type of inspection when the Pennsylvania Section, American Society of Agricultural Engineers holds its annual spring meeting April 1 and 2 at the University.

The engineers have devoted a half-day of their busy program to a study of the automatic equipment, construction, ventilation, and other features incorporated into the new structures. Harold V. Walton, section chairman announced. The rest of the sessions are devoted to technical reports, most of them from machinery, power, equipment, and industrial engineers concerned with farm sales and service.

As a multiple-use unit, the new barns provide facilities for teaching dairy production to University students, operate as a large institutional production plant, and yet the principal interest lies in a series of research studies. Management features are under investigation in virtually every approach to compare efficiency of nearly every detail involved in dairy operations.

DIAGNOSTIC LAB LOOK ON POULTRY PROBLEMS

Installation of necessary equipment has just been completed to outfit the new Poultry Diagnostic Laboratory on the campus of the Pennsylvania State University. This "lab," part of a new state-wide program, is designed to aid poultrymen in quick analyzing their health and disease problems. It is hoped this speedy service may halt any disease outbreak from reaching epidemic proportions.

Poultrymen can bring their ailing birds direct to the lab where trained technicians can analyze and diagnose the problems.

KHAKI CAN MEANS COLOR OR TYPE OF MATERIAL

The word "Khaki" will do its best this year to confuse consumers this year.

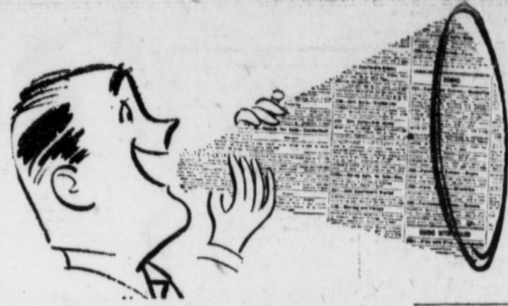
Bernice J. Tharp, clothing specialist of The Pennsylvania State University, reports that khaki can mean either a specific color or a type of material.

Current fashion, however, has taken some of the basic Army fabrics and turned them into smooth, trim costumes. These garments are available in a range of colors.

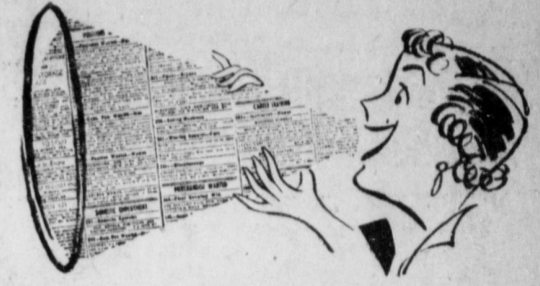

WAYS TO PREVENT TELEVISION PROBLEM

Mix television and "kids" — and a problem often results. The problem is how long to let the children view television at night. Marguerite L. Duvall, extension family life specialist at the Penna. State University, has this to say about the problem.

"Parents are better judges of what is good for children than the children are. Parents should exercise their authority but with thoughtfulness — on the television debate.

"If they, too, watch the programs their children view, they will be better able to talk about them. Too many parents yield to children's teasing about television hours when discussion with the children might be the cure.

"If a child is given good reasons for not doing what he wants to do, he'll be less likely to be resentful."
