This is my day to throw bouquets to the Architects and Builders... and let's not forget those wonderful people who make those built-in kitchen cabinets!

I've seen cabinets in all sorts of luxurious woods, and in all-white metal, chip-proof enamel in good kitchen colors. A particularly nice one has what they choose to call "Merry-Go-Round" corners... regular shelves built like lazy-susans so that everything is easily available. One of these built-in arrangements which appeals to me most of all is a new development this year. They've designed cabinets to go directly over the range. That in itself, is probably no great news. But here's the secret. Tucked away inside the cabinet is a powerful ventilating fan by a name you probably don't know. It removes, right at the source, all those greasy vapors which film, spot and discolor work, walls, windows, furnishings, draperies and floors. The fan is so compact that there is still lots of useable shelf space inside the cabinet, and some of the cabinet people have put little spice holders etc. right in the cabinet and handy to the stove. The Twin-Blower has a filter which is easily washed in your dishwasher, much easier than washing those greasy films off the walls and woodwork. In addition it makes cooking far more comfortable by removing intense cooking heat. Also, let's face it, some foods produce a rather unpleasant odor while cooking, this built-in, over-the-range fan removes them right at their source.

I thought my kitchen really was a model kitchen, and complete as could be. But now I have a little job ahead of me. I may have to cook turnips every night for the next few weeks to convince friend husband, but as far as I'm concerned my kitchen won't be complete until I get that fan in an over-the-range kitchen cabinet.

Annual Fishing Contest Scheduled

Starting July 1, restrictions on fishing along the Holtwood tailrace below the laboratory building, which were imposed for national security reasons after the Korean War broke out, will be lifted during the daylight hours, it was announced today.

Word that the lower tailrace — known as an excellent spot for fishermen — will once more be open, came with the announcement of the annual Hydro Fishing Club Contest, sponsored by the Pennsylvania Water & Power Company and the Safe Harbor Water Power Corporation, in cooperation with the Federated Sportsmen of Lancaster County and the York County Federation of Sportsmen's Clubs.

In a letter to more than 7,000 members of the Hydro Fishing Club, M. W. Seitz, public relations representative of the two power companies in Lancaster said:

"We are pleased to report that the Pennsylvania Fish Commission advises that the 1953 Lake Aldred and Lake Clarke stocking program has been very heavy. Included in the program were the placing of one million Walleye fry, of which 500,000 were stocked in each lake. You will recall that the Companies pay \$9,000 annually to aid this program.

"In addition to this program, the Penna. Fish Commission has assured us that in the near future they propose a biological survey of the lake waters to determine for future use the best answers to fishing problems in the river. They have also announced that they are considering an earlier opening date for the Walleye season which they expect will make fishing for this species much more effective. They believe that the two lakes are presently heavily populated with Walleyes which do not feed often during the warm weather and in fact, move to deep water to get into lower water temperatures. They are convinced that nowhere in Pennsylvania is there a greater concentration of Walleyes than in the two lakes comprising the Hydro Fishing Club Contest area."

Pro Forma Consolidated Earnings (giving effect to ownership of 91% of The Scranton Electric Company stock as if such stock had been acquired and the Pennsylvania shares issued in exchange had been outstanding throughout the period) after all charges accruing to the common stock of Pennsylvania Power and Light Company for the twelve months ending February 28, 1954 were \$15,265,332 equivalent to \$3.09 per share of common stock outstanding at such date, as compared with \$12,111,223 or \$2.45 per share on the same pro forma consolidated basis for 12 months ended February 28, 1953.

Consolidated revenues for the twelve months ending February 28, 1954 were \$107,506,977, an increase of 7.8% over the revenues for the previous year.
