**Good News Clubs**  
Plan Rallies

Three rallies will climax the season's activities of the Child Evangelism Fellowship of Lancaster County, sponsors of Good News Club and children's Bible classes. The main rally will be held in the McCaskey High School Auditorium, Sunday afternoon, May 2, 2:30 p.m. and sectional rallies will be held at the Gap Fire Hall, Thursday evening, April 29, 7:30 p. m. and the Grace E. C.
