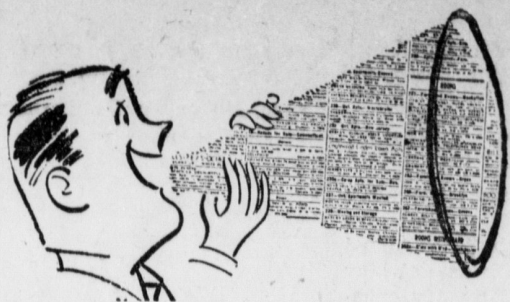

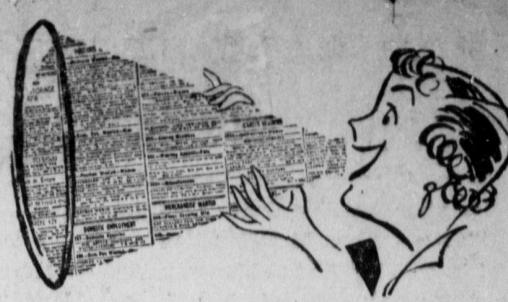

The School District of the Township of East Donegal gives notice that its School Board intends to adopt a resolution on May 14, 1954, at 7:00 P.
