METHODIST CONFERENCE TOTO BE SPONSORED

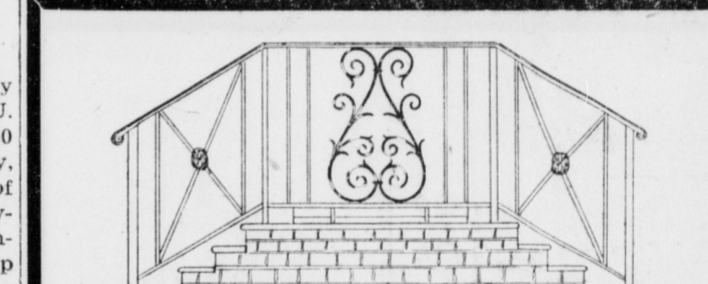

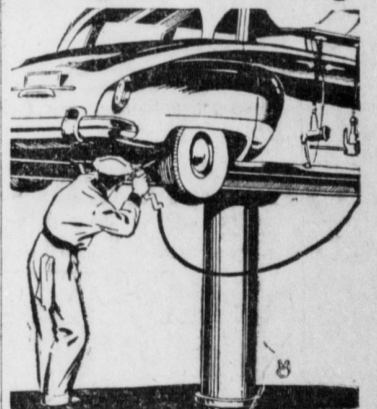
