It is being built by Herman Wohlsen, Sons, for the base cost of \$47,593.

The building will care for the needs of children from nursery to intermediate age. The architect is Coleman and Coleman, Landisville. J. Richard Nissley, Landisville, is chairman of the expansion committee. The Rev. Ernest P. Leer is pastor of the church.
