### PP&L Appoints Busby As V. Pres.

Jack K. Busby, formerly general counsel of Pennsylvania Power & Light Company, was appointed vice president and general counsel by the utility company's Board of Directors at a meeting in the Allentown general office Tuesday, May 25.

The legal vice presidency of the company had been vacant since the resignation of the late Thos. J. Perkins, who gave up the position on April 30, 1949, although he continued as a company director and consulting counsel until his death in early 1952.

The newly-appointed vice president joined PP&L on December 1, 1951, as general counsel. Except for a four year period spent as a Navy lieutenant during World War II, he had been associated with the New York law firm of Simpson and Bartlett since graduation from law school.

Mr. Busby's wife, the former Elise Hohle of New York, like her husband is a member of the legal profession. A graduate of Hunter College, she also is a Yale law school graduate and was formerly associated with Simpson Thatcher & Bartlett. The Busbys, who were married in 1947 and the parents of a 2-year-old son, Leonard, live at Zionsville Rl. Pa.

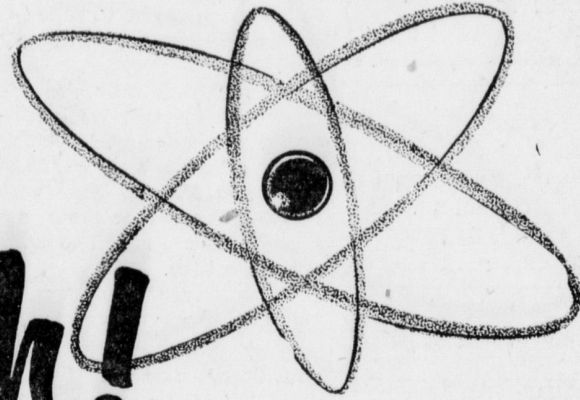
