Homemakers' Week Is June 28 At Penn State

Women from all counties in the state are invited to attend the second annual Extension Homemakers Week to be held at the Pennsylvania State University, State College, from June 28 to July 1.

Eleven special interest groups are featured on the program and each homemaker will be able to choose two of them. The topics to be discussed or demonstrated include landscaping the home grounds, aids to good grooming, simple flower arrangements where the women will actually work with flowers themselves, understanding teenagers, money management for the family, learning to live with art, weaving as a hobby, appreciation of music, family recreation and a weight-control clinic.

Since most of these interest groups are set up as workshops, the women will have a chance to actively participate in them. The meetings of the group will begin at 9 o'clock Tuesday morning and continue until the lunch hour. The same topics will be repeated again Wednesday morning. A homemaker will be chairman of each session and each group will have a speaker.

Other features of the three-day program are a chicken barbecue in Hort Woods, a vespers service in charge of homemakers, a homemaker's talent show or "fun night", tours of the campus and University farms and a song fest.

Speakers on the program are Mrs. Mildred Buchanan Flag, Newtonville, Mass. who is a well-known author, editor, orator, traveler and an outstanding speaker. She will speak on "The Family in a Chaotic World."

A number of Lancaster County women are planning to attend this program at the University, many of whom were there last year. The cost for the week is \$15.85 plus the \$1.00 registration fee which is paid upon arrival.

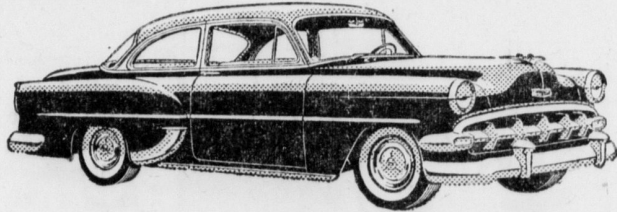
