Vehicles Involved In Florin Crash

Damage to four vehicles involved in an accident on the Harrisburg Pike at Florin, about 1:20 p.m. yesterday, totaled more than \$1,500, state police reported. In addition, one person was injured slightly.

Vehicles involved were operated by Freeman P. Dixon, Tallmage; John Welsh, Jr., Williamsport; Gerald Stokes, Harrisburg and Carlton Schuldt, Elizabethtown, according to state police reports.

Dixon, traveling west on the highway, told state police he believes he dozed momentarily. His sedan crossed the center of the highway, and struck a convertible operated by Welsh, police said. It missed a vehicle following Welsh's car, but struck Stokes' sedan and then sideswiped a pick-up truck operated by Schuldt, according to police. Dixon's car was damaged to the extent of about \$700. Welsh's convertible about \$200. Stokes' sedan about \$600 and Schuldt's truck only slightly.

Dixon suffered a slight head injury and was treated by Dr. Thomas O'Connor, Mount Joy.

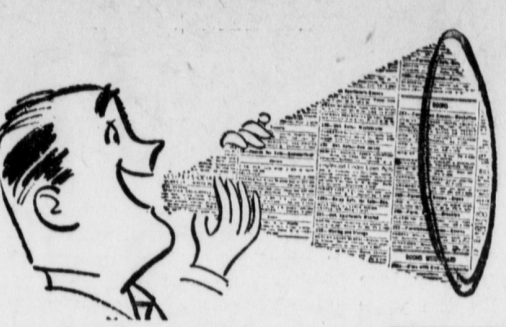

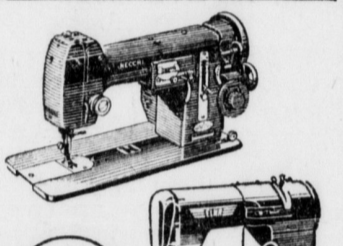
