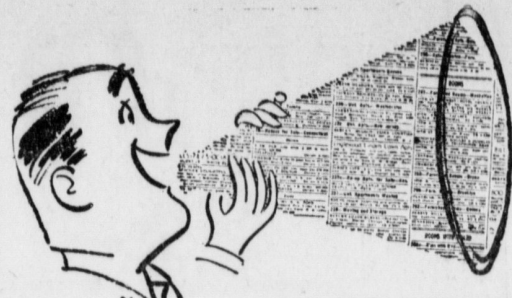
Speed Vegetable Preparation—When washing spinach or other greens, put them in a big pan of water. Pat gently to loosen grit and soil without bruising leaves. Then lift them out instead of draining the water off them. Louise Hamilton, Penn State extension nutritionist, says this way you lift the greens from the soil that has settled to the bottom and washing takes less time.

Select Large Buttons—If you must use buttons on preschool children's clothes, select those that are at least a half inch in diameter, suggests Mae B. Barton, Penn State extension clothing specialist. The flat, round ones with a grooved edge are easy for youngsters to hold on to. Avoid unusual shapes, such as animals and flowers.

Background Makes Difference—Clear and strong colored walls call for black and white prints or pictures. Neutral walls of gray and tan make good backgrounds for brightly colored pictures, reports Sanna Black, Penn State extension home management specialist.

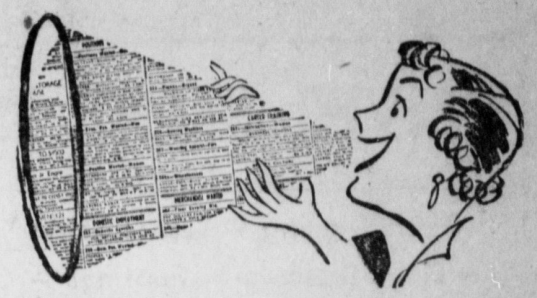
HOLDS CARD TABLES

Sealed proposal will be received by Mount Joy Borough Authority at the offices of the Gerberich-Payne Shoe Company, located on West Main Street in Mount Joy Borough, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania until 8:00 P. M., Daylight Saving Time, on July 26, 1954 for the construction of a reinforced concrete foundation for a 1,000,000 Gallon Steel Water Storage Tank (to be constructed by others), and also the construction of Bituminous Pavement Adjacent thereto. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud.

The foundation will be constructed of reinforced concrete, with a base approximately twenty-nine feet in radius and height of four and one-half feet, containing approximately three hundred fifty cubic yards of concrete and 65,000 pounds of steel bars. The foundation is located at the corner of David and Lumber Streets in Mount Joy Borough, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania.
