## More Certified Seed For Barley And Oats

Harrisburg — Pennsylvania farmers this fall will have larger amounts of State certified winter barley and winter oats seed available than ever before, according to the Bureau of Plant Industry, Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture. A record total of 2,172 acres of winter barley grown for seed passed all field inspection by bureau agents. Seeds from these

acres will be eligible for State certification provided it meets requirements for germination and purity, according to C. F. Campbell, in charge of seed certification in the Bureau. The acreage entered for inspection totaled 3,562 but 1,390 acres had to be rejected by inspectors due to the presence of weeds, disease or other crops appearing in the fields.

There were 203 acres of winter oats entered for inspection for seed certification this year compared with less than 95 acres in 1953. This year 85 acres passed field inspection and 117 acres were rejected.

Varieties and acreages of winter barley that passed inspection include 2,062 acres of Wong; 1,425 of Kenbar and 75 of Kentucky. All winter oats acreage was the LeConte variety.

Lists of growers of these seeds may be obtained on request to the State Department of Agriculture, Harrisburg, or from local county farm agents.

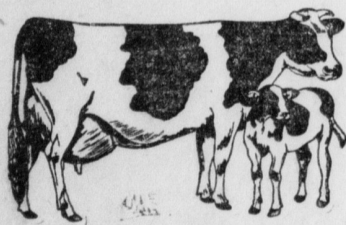

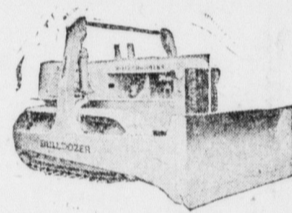
