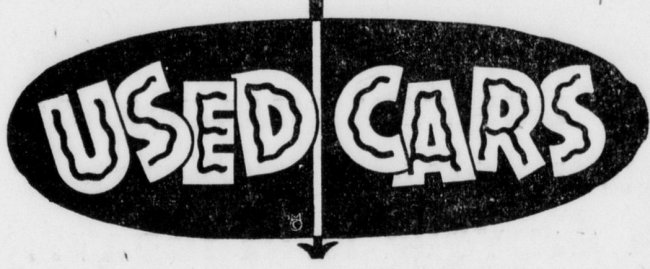

## YOUR HEALTH

"Doctor, I have heart disease. Should I fly?"  
This is an oft-repeated question to the physician. When a survey some years ago showed that out of a total of seven million passengers carried by five major airlines only three deaths occurred aloft, the conclusion was made that "if you can walk you may fly."

This generalization has proved to be sound, for subsequently information obtained by the Civil Aeronautics Administration recorded but one death aloft for every one and one-half million passengers carried, with the leading cause of death being cardiovascular disease.

It is noted that more incidence of death has occurred in the nonpressurized type of airplane cabin than in the pressurized type, despite differences in altitude during flight. Some physicians are of the opinion that patients with cardiac decompensation or severe high blood pressure should not fly.

However, it is generally accepted that patients who have well-compensated valvular disease or mild uncomplicated high blood pressure can fly with out risk. On the pressurized-cabin type of plane, there is rarely need for the administration of oxygen to persons with heart disease.

A physician can advise his heart patient to use the pressurized-type of airplane and be assured of safety and comfort without the necessity of using oxygen. Oxygen, nevertheless, should still be on the airplane and readily available at all times for an emergency.

To be entirely on the safe side, a person with heart disease should be advised not to engage passage on any type of airliner that does not have a supply of oxygen aboard for emergency use.

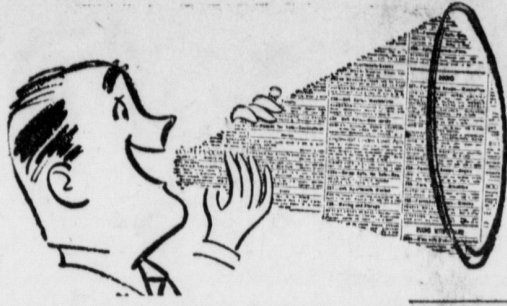

## Dual Vaccination Urged For Dogs

A dual vaccination program was recommended today by the American Foundation for Animal Health as a defense against two of the most widespread dog diseases, distemper and infectious hepatitis.

Recent studies show that both may occur simultaneously in the dog, with only one being detected because of the similarity of symptoms. Dual infections produce a much higher mortality rate than cases where only one of the disease is present, according to the Foundation.

Vaccination of pups at weaning age was also recommended to prevent encephalitis, or sleeping sickness, which has been reported with increasing frequency as a development of the distemper complex.

The Foundation warned against considering such immunization programs as providing permanent protection. Dogs leading a semi-secluded life need booster inoculations at regular intervals. Those in heavily populated areas with free access to streets usually experience constant exposure to virulent virus which may have the same effect as a booster.

Inoculating brood dogs a few weeks before breeding is good practice, said the Foundation. Immunizing antibodies are passed along in the milk to protect puppies during their critical early days.

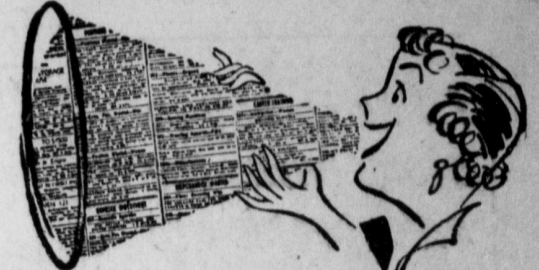
CLEAN BED
