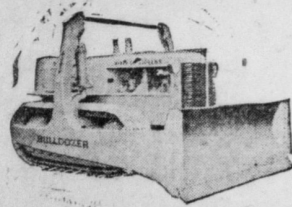

Farmers Are Urged To Drive Trucks Carefully

More farm people lose their lives in motor vehicle mishaps than in any other class of accident, declared Walter W. Matthews of the Philadelphia Safety Council.

"That is why we urge all the farm folk to drive carefully with their farm trucks when they are out on the highway," said Matthews, also a member of the Pennsylvania Rural Safety Council. The Council is engaging in a state-wide effort to wipe out accidents in rural areas.

"The cost and penalties for traffic accidents run too high to gamble with," Matthews continued, "Every truck driver must know and follow the rules of the road. Trucks must also be kept in a safe mechanical condition.

"Don't gamble with poor lights, defective brakes or steering and poor windshield wipers. Don't wait till the dead line of the inspection period, but have repairs made promptly and thus save lives and property.
