

Is Danger To Linemen

Pennsylvania Power & Light Company resently instituted a program to discourge the posting of placards on the Company's service poles. According to Mr. G. T. Storb, vice presim. Watch for itemized list in ion, cooperation by all groups will help prevent linemen accidents and aid in the safer maintenance of dependable electric service in Central Eastern Pennsvlvania.

The utility executive explained that nails, tacks or staples used in the posting of pole signs have caused numerous injuries to its linemen in past years. The injuries occur when a lineman's climbing spurs strike such metal objects and cut loose, and the man is either badly lacerated by the rusty nails and torn staples as he slips downward or, in more extreme cases, he actually tumbles from the pole to be seriously hurt.

Further evidence of the seriousness of the problem to electric company linemen as well as telephone workers and others is the fact that the state legislature last year passed P. L. Act No. 360 making posting of signs on service poles unlawful. However, not realizing the serious ness of the situations, some groups have continued postings despite the state lawmakers' ac

Realizing that people who fasten signs to service poles are simply unaware of the possible ate and personal property. 


