Utility Companies' Directors Approve Proposed Merger
 In a joint statement Chas E. Oakes, president, Pennsylvania Power & Light Company and George W. Spaulding, president, Pennsylvania Water & Power Company, have announced that the board of Directors of both companies had approved a merger agreement under which Pennsylvania Water & Power Company will merge into Pennsylvania Power & Light Company necessary stockholder, regulatory and other approvals are forthcoming.
 The merger agreement provides, among other things, that each share of common stock of Pennsylvania Water & Power Co. will be entitled in the merger to receive one quarter of PP & L Co. 4.40% series preferred stock and one half share of PP & L Co. common stock. The agreement also provides that the preferred stocks of P.W.P. Co. will be called for redemption at the respective redemption prices prior to Consumption of the merger.
 Stockholders' meeting of both companies will be called about December 15, 1954 to consider approval of the merger agreement.
 Pennsylvania Water & Power Co., incorporated January 13th, 1910 is an independent, investor-owned public utility engaged in the production, transmission and wholesaling of electric power. The company owns and operates a Hydro and a Steam Elect-

 One thousand, three hundred and 42 persons were admitted to the Lancaster General Hospital during September, it was announced by Dr. D. C. Smelzer Executive Director of the hospital, at a meeting of the board of directors Monday.
 The admitted patients required 11,197 days of hospital service. Other census figures include:
 Patients discharged during the month, 1,278; Number of operations, 540; Number of births, 294; 1,029 patients were treated in the Receiving Ward. 445 patients were treated in the Dispensary with 614 visits. The average number of patients per day was 373.
