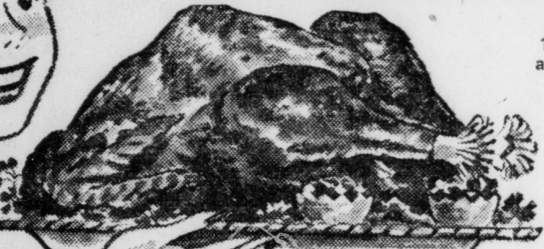

Urges Parents Aid To Combat Auto Vandalism

Halloween vandalism, particularly as it applies to costly automobiles, is denounced by the Keystone Automobile Club in a statement urging parents, school teachers and police to impress on youngsters that destructive pranks are criminal rather than "funny."

"Considering the high cost of ownership and maintenance of the modern automobile," said Edward P. Curran, the Club's Safety Director, "it is imperative that children be warned against defacing and breakage in the mistaken belief they are having 'fun.' Parents should make certain the youngsters do not overstep the bounds of legitimate revelry. And police must see to it that private property is not made a target for unthinking demonstrators. Punitive action should be taken where such practices result in damage."

"Motorists long have been subjected to destructive acts of children that are totally inexcusable. Painting and marking cars with chalk and soap is a most obnoxious practice. The finish on many expensive cars has been virtually ruined on 'mischief' nights. Breaking of milk bottles is another practice that must be discouraged and the breakers punished. The motoring public is penalized thousands of dollars for damage caused by glass in the streets. When 'fun' reaches this expensive stage it becomes plain vandalism. Broken door handles, and stolen radiator caps and gas tank caps, are other items of needless expense."

"We appeal to parents and teachers to help prevent such acts of Halloween vandalism. We also suggest that motorists out their cars in garages especially on Halloween night and the night before in order to cut
