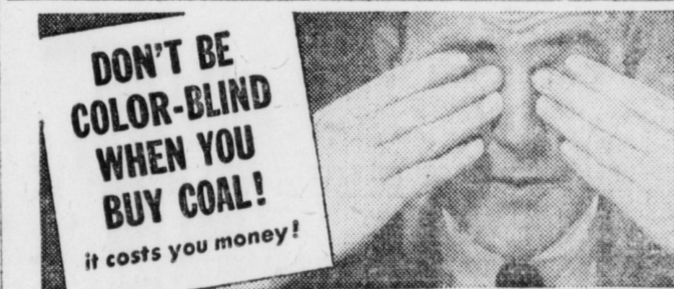

Farm Bureau
Facilities Visited
By 2,300 Farmers

More than 2,300 Pennsylvania farmers inspected two farm-owned Farm Bureau facilities in Lancaster county this summer as part of a special program.

The farmers participated in a tour program which was part of the 20th anniversary observance of the Pennsylvania Farm Bureau Cooperative Association.

George M. Myers, of Harrisburg, manager of membership relations for Pennsylvania Farm Bureau, said the program was designed to acquaint the farmers with the facilities they own as a result of 20 years of cooperative enterprise.

A total of 2,257 farmers from 29 counties toured the Farm Bureau feed mill and seed plant at Manheim, while 837 visited the organization's eastern warehouse at Florin.

Thirty-four tours were made to the Manheim facilities, while 12 groups were conducted thru the Florin operation.

During the entire eight-month program, a total of 3622 farmers from 39 counties took part in 67 tours.
