Elizabethtown College Choir To Sing Sunday

The Elizabethtown college cappella choir will present their annual Service of Sacred Music in the Church of the Brethren in Elizabethtown, this coming Sunday morning at 10:30 a. m. The choir numbers 40 mixed voices this year, of whom more than half are vocal soloists.

1955 is the 20th anniversary year of the founding of the organization. In recognition of this fact, the choir has doubled its repertoire, preparing 2 complete programs in one season—the one sacred, and the other a secular concert. Their present director, Professor Nevin W. Fisher, is a graduate of the Eastman School of Music, holds a Master's degree from the Choral Music Department of Northwestern University and was formerly an instructor in the Peabody Conservatory of Baltimore, Maryland.

The choir is scheduled to sing in many churches, high schools and civic auditoriums of Pennsylvania this spring.
