Marlin Myers was named financial secretary and treasurer to replace Marshall Dussinger who resigned from the position last month.

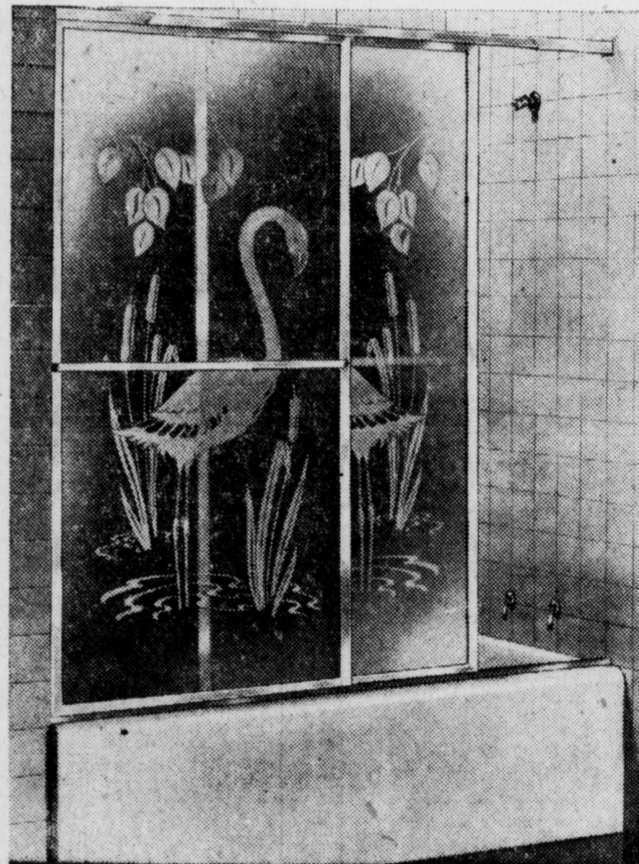
