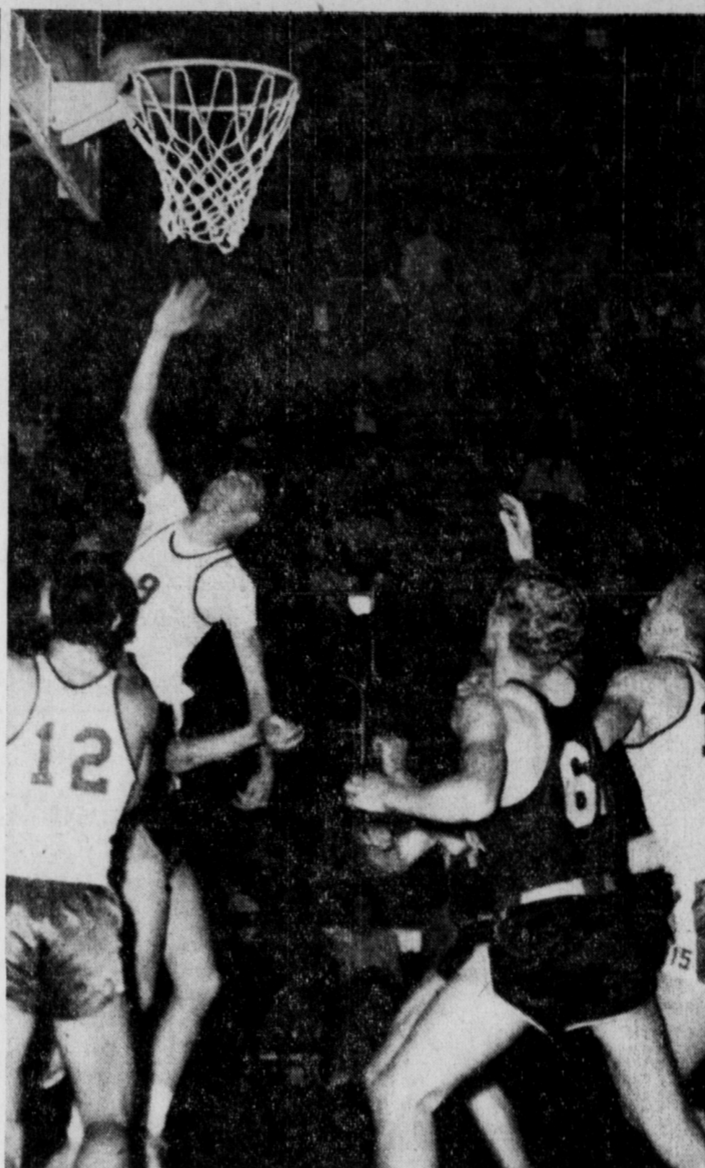

Donegal Wins In District Semi-Finals

The Donegal Indians defeated Swatara Twp., Tuesday evening in the District 3 Semi-finals, 58 to 41, at the Hershey Arena.

Playing their second game within five days at Hershey, Donegal was unable to build up a sizeable lead for three quarters, and at times appeared to be over anxious. On the other hand, Swatara seemed to be very calm and determined to give Donegal a battle every inch of the way. Donegal was seeking their 23d straight win and second in the District play-off.

Swatara surprised every one by taking a 6-0 lead in the opening minutes of the contest, then Donegal bounced back and took a short lived lead, but some sharp shooting by Terry Benney and Dick Hair enabled Swatara to take a 13-10 lead at the first quarter.

In the second period, Metzler Kugle, and Grove outscored Benney and Hair to take a three point lead at the half.

At the start of the second half the Indians stretched their lead to seven points, only to have Peck and Benny intercept 2 passes and score two fast goals to close the gap to three points again. Donegal managed to out-score Swatara in this period but could not stretch their lead. Score at the third quarter, 35 to 31.

Going into the final period Donegal again pulled away to an eight point lead, but the scrappy Swatara team fought back to within two points. At this point in a scramble under Donegal's basket, Metzler received a lower lip laceration and after first aid was administered, Jay returned to action amid a rousing ovation from the crowd.

The injury to Jay was probably the spark that Donegal needed. After that they seemed to be an entirely different ball club, and started to hit the basket with rapid succession, and before Swatara could rally to cope with the situation, it was all over but the shouting.

Saturday, March 12, Donegal will meet Palmira for the District 3 title at Albright College Reading. Tickets for this game are on sale at the High School only.

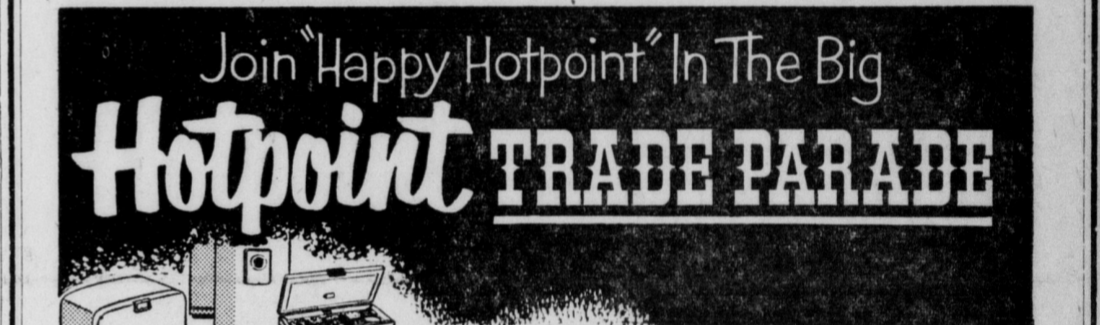
