INDIANS TAKE TO WARPATH

**Scalp Unionville
In Thriller, 62-56**

Donegal's fast stepping Indians ran rough-shod over the height laden tribe of Indians of Unionville 62-56 Tuesday evening at Upper Darby High School to enter the Semi-finals.

This victory was the 25th straight for the Indians from the Donegal reservation, and was probably one of their most impressive wins, for the first this year Donegal was up against a team that was superior in height.

Four of Unionville's starting five were 2 or 3 inches over six feet, with their center "Dick" Geesey 6-7. This however proved to be no handicap to the smaller Indians, Metzler who was pretty well bottled up the entire game, but still managed to score 11 points, played one of his best defensive games of the year. 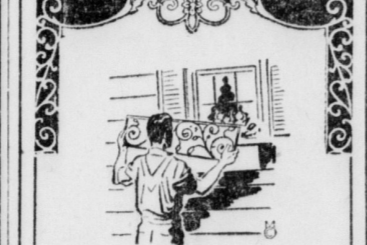

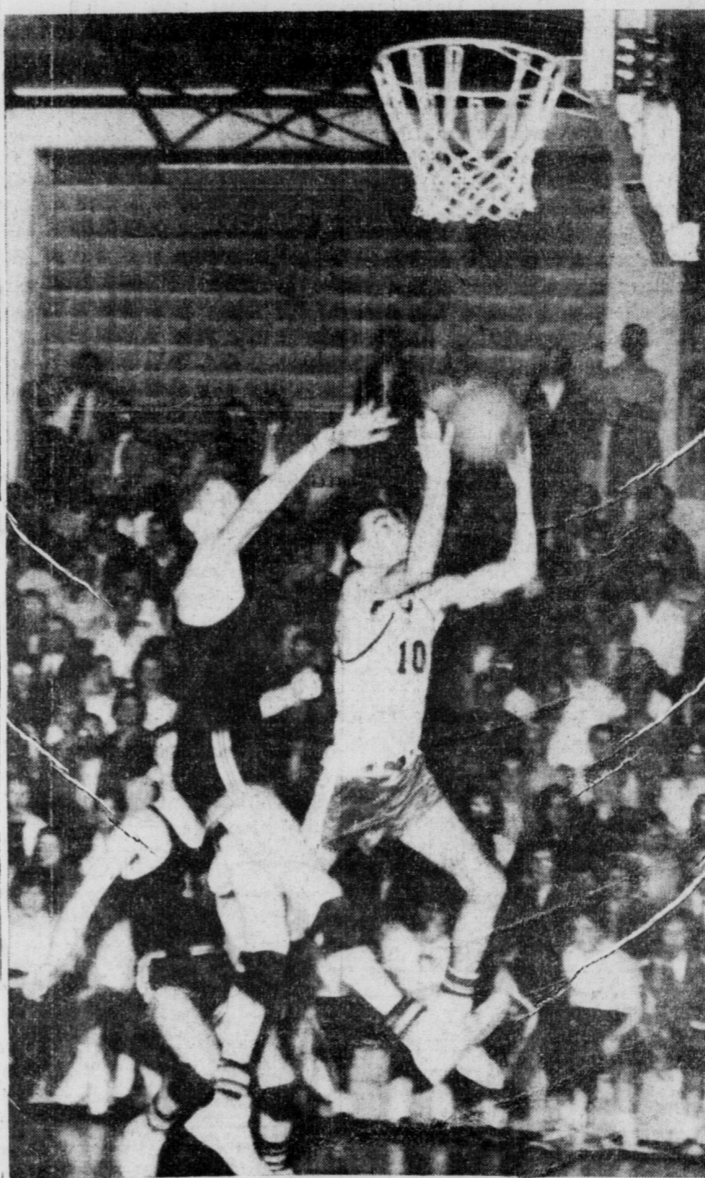

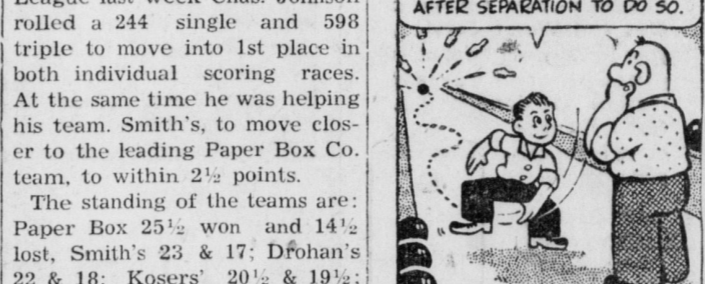
