Open House At Palsy Center

Residents of Lancaster city and county are invited to visit the Pre-school Cerebral Palsy Center during its "Open House" Thursday, March 24, from 1 to 3 p. m. The invitation was extended by Walter C. Miller, President of the Lancaster Co. Society for Crippled Children & Adults, Inc.

Visitors will see their Easter Seal contributions in action to help crippled children. The kindergarten teacher and therapists will demonstrate care and treatment procedures representative of services offered to children at the facility throughout the year. "We look forward to meeting those generous folks who offer a 'helping hand' to Easter Seal facilities. Continued help for crippled children depend upon their contributions", Miller said.

The Pre-school cerebral Palsy Center represents one of the many services given by the Lancaster County Society for Crippled Children & Adults, Inc. Its other services, financed by Easter Seal funds, are clinics for examinations, diagnoses and recommendations; treatment center for physical and occupational therapy treatments; close supervision of shoes, braces, and post-operative cases by an orthopedic nurse; corrective swimming class; purchase of shoes, braces and appliances for those who cannot afford to do so and loan of equipment for rehabilitation.
