**Reserved For You**  
Program Offers Courses Before Enlistments

When opportunity knocks a second time for the same individual, he considers himself really lucky. The Army has come up with a program that has opportunity knocking not once, not twice—but more than a hundred times, it was announced by M/Sgt. Charles Sonberger, NCO in-charge of the local Army Recruiting Station, Post Office Bldg., Lancaster.

Directed at the high school senior and recent graduates, Sgt. Sonberger said this "Reserved for You" program gives qualified applicants the choice of more than 100 technical courses BEFORE they enlist in the Regular Army. If all requirements are met and a vacancy exists in one of the desired courses, the young man or woman applying will be signed up for an Army enlistment — with a written guaranty of class enrollment in hand!

The recruiting Sergeant went on to say, here's another interesting angle on the program: The applicant is not obligated to enlist even after he or she has been accepted for the program. Acceptance merely means that the person has been found eligible for a vacancy. The decision on taking the technical training is still his to make. If the applicant chooses to enlist, he goes into the Army with a career course reservation.

Courses range from atomic weapons and automotive repair to photography and wire maintenance. There is schooling to lead to specialization in every field of interest.

Sgt. Sonberger said that there is a 48-page school catalog, entitled "Reserved for You", is available free of charge at the local Army Recruiting Station located at The Post Office, Lancaster, Pa. or phone 47724. This book describes each of the courses in the program, plus prerequisites for the Army enlistment and course enrollment.
