## Automobile Club

### Favors 'Sight

### Summons' Law

Keystone Automobile Club announces it is backing in the Pennsylvania Legislature a program designed to modernize the Vehicle Code by strengthening the enforcement arm of government while at the same time abolishing inequities in some present procedures which have been the subject of criticism.

Specifically, the club favors enactment of a "sight summons" law as a realistic substitute for the cumbersome summons-by-mail procedure, a "point system" for disciplining and suspending traffic violators, a uniform "fix-proof" traffic ticket, and a practical approach to the subject of re-examination of drivers over the age of sixty-five.

"The objective of the 'Sight Summons' Bill," said J. Maxwell Smith, president of the Club, "is to facilitate enforcement of traffic laws while safeguarding the motoring public from arbitrary use of police power, which was the controlling factor in the legislative decision many years ago to take away from local police the authority to arrest on sight for minor offenses."

"Under the provisions of a bill local authorities in municipalities are authorized to establish special magistrates' courts before which all informations charging traffic violations may be brought. Whenever such courts have been established, a salaried police officer in uniform not compensated in any way by fines, may stop an alleged offender and present to him a notice to appear before the special court. This notice, or 'sight summons' shall have the same effect as the summons personally sent by registered mail."

"Failure to appear in the issuance of a warrant. The advantage to police departments in this procedure will be elimination of the great volume of work in connection with the mailing notices. It will permit instant action by policemen the scene of the alleged violation, without, however, taking him from his post of duty as in the instance of physical arrest for minor offenses and the hauling of an offender before a magistrate."

## Navy Recruiter

### Announces New

### Assignment Policy

Chief L. James Stevens of the Lancaster Navy Recruiting Office building, announced today a new Navy policy regarding assignment to duty of persons with previous service. The new Policy gives any man who reenlists in the Navy, or a man with previous service other than Navy, the opportunity to state that he wants duty in the Pacific and be assured of getting it before he is sworn in.

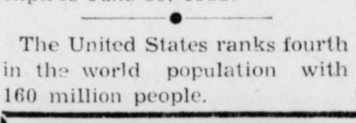
The same applies to the man who wants to serve his "Next Cruise" in the Atlantic. Sailors have always been travelers, and this new policy makes it possible for a man who served one "Cruise" in the Atlantic to make the next one in the Pacific.

If a man reenlists within 30 days, he will be given his thirty days' reenlistment leave with orders to report to the coast of his choice. Chief Stevens also reminds all concerned that if they were discharged from the Navy during the past year, they may be able to reenlist and get their old rate back. This provision expires June 30, 1955.
