**Don't Enlist Until High School Graduation Recruiter Advises**

Don't enlist in the Regular Army until you've graduated from high school, is the advice recruiters give to young men attending high school who apply for enlistment at the U. S. Army Recruiting Station, Post Office Bldg., Lancaster.

M/Sgt. Charles Sonberger, NCO in charge of the local station, said that men who graduate from high school have a much broader field to choose from when applying for enlistment. He said graduates joining the Regular Army have a choice of 100 Army technical schools and Regular Army have a choice of before they are enlisted, the Army Security Agency is also open to them, and while in the Army they will find that their high school education will serve them well, not only in advancements to higher pay, but on their job as well.
