### CHALK ARTIST TO APPEAR AT ELIZABETHTOWN CHURCH GOOD FRIDAY

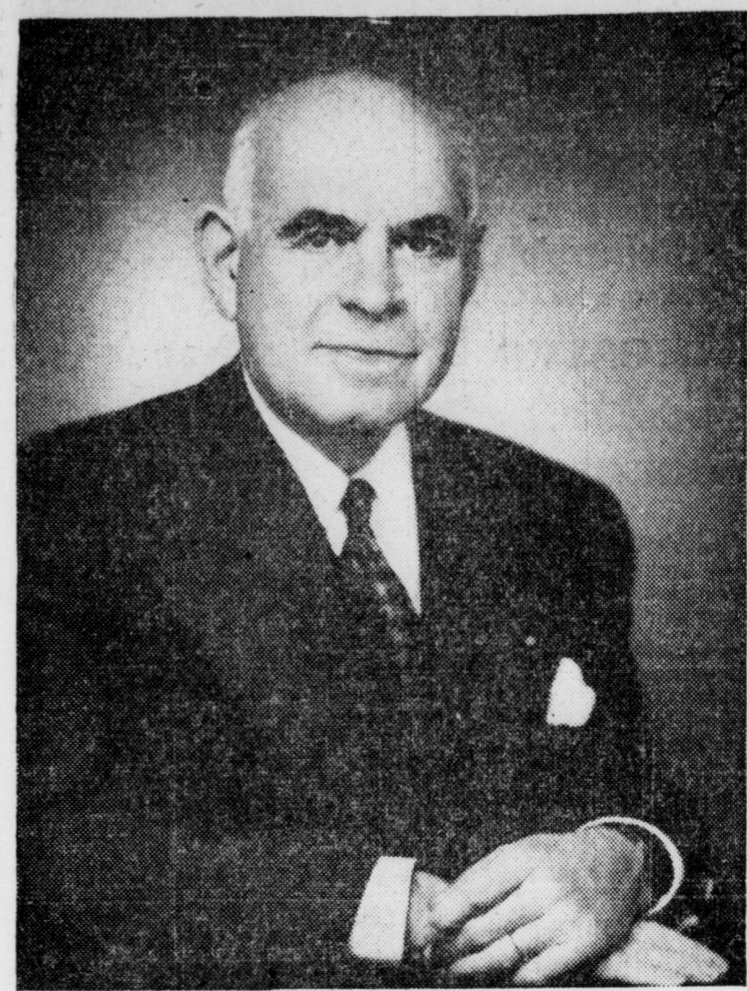
