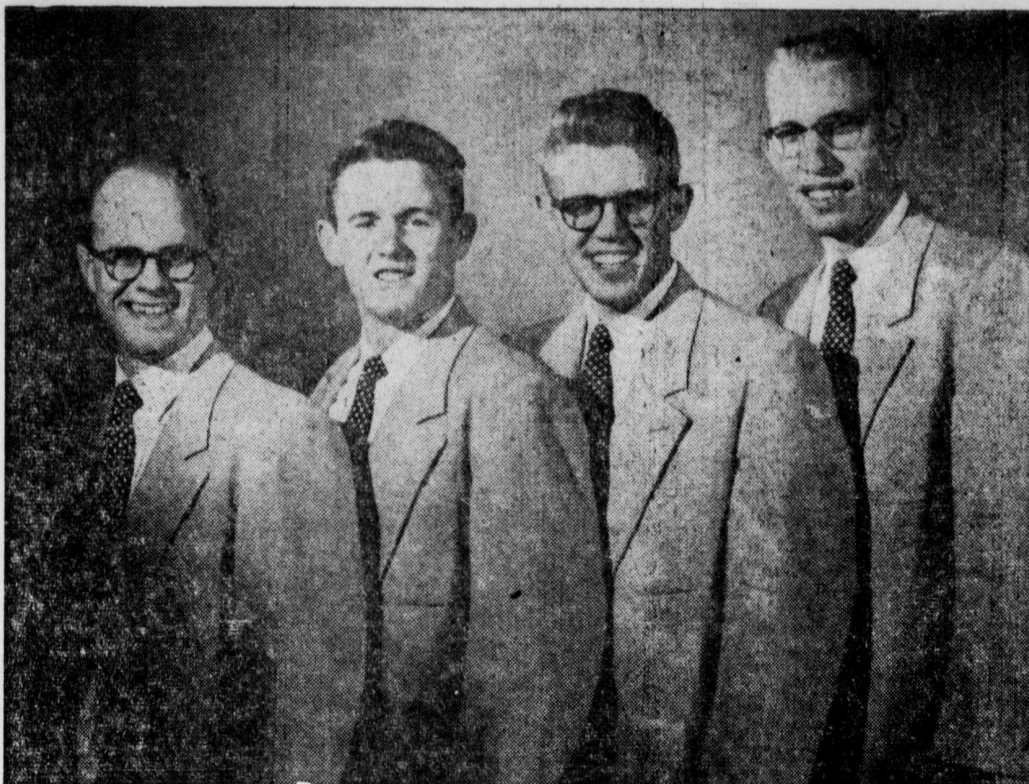

**Upland College Quartet Appears Here April 12th**

The Volunteers Quartet of Upland College of Upland, Calif.,

will be appearing in the Cross Roads Brethren in Christ Church, Mount Joy, on April 12, at 7:30 p.m. These four fellows, who have travelled extensively throughout Southwestern United States and appeared in coast-to-coast tours will be visiting this

community for one day. Accompanied by John Z. Martin, president of Upland College, the fellows will present a musical-inspirational program that will include such favorite numbers as "The Unveiled Christ," "After," and "I Got a Robe."

The quartet is composed of Myron Mann from Clayton, O.; Orval Eshelman from White City, Kansas; Loren Wiese of Arnolds Park, Iowa; and Marlin Niesley of Carlisle, Pa.

Upland College is a four-year liberal arts college located about forty miles east of Los Angeles and provides offerings in the area of Religion, Science, Social Science, Humanities, and Education. The first tenor of the group, Myron Mann, is in his senior year. Wiese and Niesley are juniors, and Eshelman is a sophomore.

The quartet is on an 8,000-mile good-will tour travelling as far east as Toronto, Canada, and presenting a total of twenty-five programs enroute. There will be no admission charge for this program. The public is invited to attend.

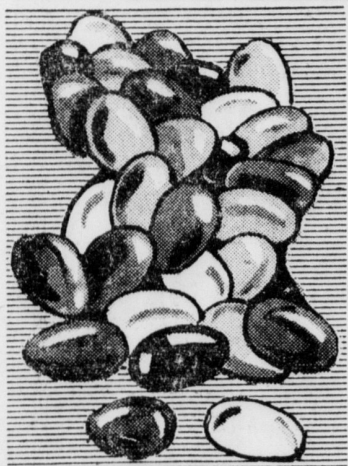

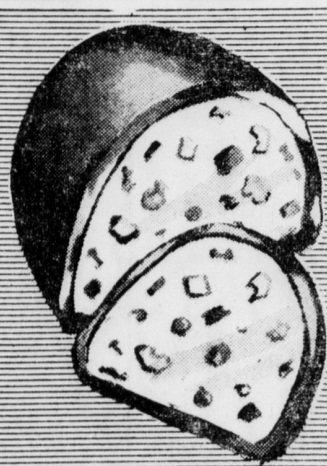

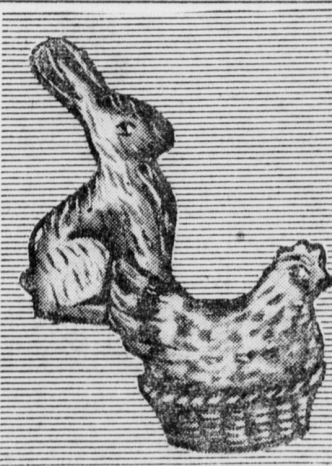
