Timely Reminders from The Pennsylvania State University College of Agriculture  
Fit Slightly — Jackets with just slight fitting in the back hide the natural waistline and make a woman with a short waist appear to have a longer one.

Control Silverfish — Silverfish can be controlled with household type lindane or chlordane. Repeat the treatment at two week intervals if necessary.

Need Less Contrast — Rooms with natural wood tones don't need sharp color contrast as do those with white or light colors.
