**MURDER MYSTERY
 FEATURED AT GRETNA**

The Broadway stage and screen success, "Dial 'M' for Murder", will begin a week's run at the Gretna Playhouse tonight. The show, produced by Charles F. Coghlan and Gene P. Otto, will play through July 27.

Earl Montgomery, who has had leading roles in "King of Hearts", "The Rainmaker" and "Oh, Men! Oh, Women", will take the part of Tony Wendice, ex-tennis star, the role created on Broadway by Maurice Evans and in the movies by Ray Milland.

Playing opposite Montgomery will be Margaret Stewart, who has had leading roles in the first six Gretna shows. Miss Stewart will portray Margot Wendice, enacted by Academy Award winning Grace Kelly in the Alfred Hitchcock film version. Jackson Young will be seen as a television writer who comes to Miss Stewart's defense when she is accused of murdering a man who has been blackmailing her.

Other important parts will be played by Harry Sheppard as the police inspector assigned to the case, and Gene Galvin as a paid assassin who is accidentally murdered. Jack Gilchrist will portray a police officer assisting the inspector. Setting for the play, the living room of the Wendices' apartment, will be designed by Robert DeMora.

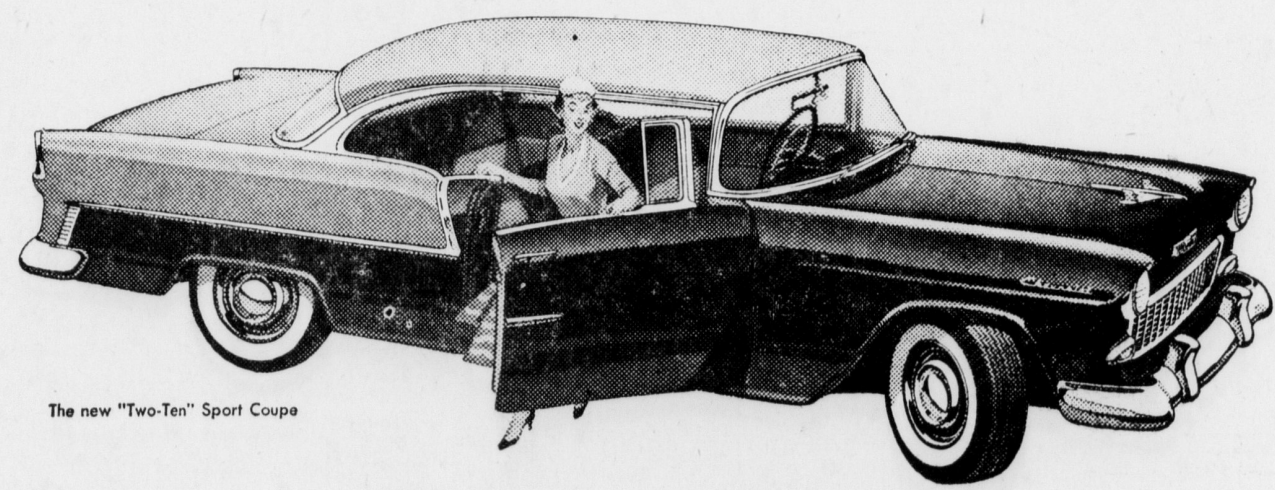
