SEALED PROPOSAL

Sealed proposal will be received by Mount Joy Borough Authority at the offices of the Gerberich-Payne Shoe Company, located on West Main Street in Mount Joy Borough, Lancaster County, Pennsylvania until 8:00 P. M., Daylight Saving Time, on October 11, 1955 for furnishing and constructing in place a 12 in. welded wrought iron transmission main encased in an 18 in. welded steel pipe over the Lumber Street bridge passing over the tracks of the Pennsylvania Railroad Co. at Mt. Joy, Pennsylvania.

Approximately 110 feet of pipe will be required which will be welded in place to the top plate of the existing eastern steel girder of the railroad bridge.

Drawings, specifications and contract documents may be examined free of charge at the offices of the Trustees of the Union National Mt. Joy Bank, during banking hours. Copies of the drawings, specifications and contract documents may be obtained from Joseph A. Michels, Registered Professional Engineer, Dallastown, RD 1, Pennsylvania upon payment of a charge of \$10, which will not be returned.

Each proposal must be accompanied by a certified check, bank cashier's or treasurer's check in an amount not less than five per cent (5%) of the base bid payable to Mt. Joy Borough Authority, in accordance with the provisions contained in the instructions to bidders. A satisfactory bid bond with corporate surety in an amount not less than five per cent (5%) of the base bid will be accepted in lieu of a check.

The checks or bid bonds of all but the two lowest bidders will be returned within ten days after the opening of the bids. The successful bidder will be required to execute a contract furnish bonds within ten (10) days after the date the Notice of Award has either been delivered or mailed to him. Upon the execution of the contract and approval of the bonds, the checks or bid bonds of the successful bidder and second bidder will be returned. Each successful bidder will be required to furnish a performance bond in the form provided in the Contract Documents with satisfactory corporate surety in the full amount of his contract and will also be required to furnish a Labor and Material Payment Bond in the form provided in the Contract Documents with satisfactory corporate surety in like amount.

All bids must be properly signed and enclosed in an opaque, sealed envelope, clearly marked with the type of bid and the bidder's name and address, or by mail to Grant D. Gerberich, Secretary of Mt. Joy Borough Authority, not later than 8:00 P. M., Daylight Saving Time on the date hereinbefore mentioned for the opening of the Proposals.

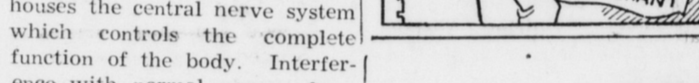
SPINAL HYGIENE WEEK OCT. 1 - 7

The week of Oct. 1 through Oct. 7 has been designated as Spinal Hygiene Week by the Chiropractic Profession of Pennsylvania, which is being sponsored by the Penna. Chiropractic Society, it was announced today by Dr. S. K. Keiser, Jr., Ephrata, Penna., Public Relations Director of Lancaster Co. Chiropractic Society.

Note of Warning To Parents
In announcing the observance of Spinal Hygiene Week, the Chiropractic Professor sounded a note of warning pointing out that postural deformities can be caused when children are forced to a sitting or standing position before their musculature is sufficiently developed. "The spine houses the central nerve system which controls the complete function of the body. Interference with normal nerve force transmission, evidenced by sloppy posture, will impair health, induce body incoordinations and render the body unable to function at full normal efficiency. Moderate encouragement is all a child needs with proper attention to posture position, and a periodic spinal check-up."

Commenting further on the importance of sitting, standing, and walking correctly, Dr. Keiser says, "avoid vertebral subluxations or have them properly corrected since they are the primary cause of all ill-health. A straight spine is the shortest distance to good health."
